Meeting of December 15, 2016

Annual Fiscal Audit: Kimberley Temple of Wall Smith, Bateman & Associates presented the 2016 Annual Fiscal Audit. Questions were answered as they surfaced.

Resignation. The Board accepted the resignation of Cassandra Medina from Food Service.

Employment. The Board approved Juan Archuleta as Food Service Employee and Denise Gomez as Middle School Girls Basketball Coach. They also approved Armando Avila, David Maurice Hirsch, and John Lomashey (pending receipt of authorization) as Guest Teachers (Certified). Board also approved Felicia Acosta and Carol Manzanares as Guest Substitute (Classified).

Items from the Audience. Erika Medina Junior Class President presented on the senior trip for the class of 2018. Noel Heredia Senior Class President and Steven Valdez presented on the senior trip for the class of 2017.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Webb reported on a destroyed back flow preventer at Bill Metz, reconsideration requests, changes with ESSA, CASB Convention and on the satellite land.

Mill Levy Certification. The Board approved the 2017 mill levy of 41.642 mills which includes a general fund mill levy of 30.892 mills (includes .146 for abatement and 3.60 voter approved override) and a bond redemption mill levy of 10.75.

Other Action Items. The Board approved the minutes of the November 10, 2016 meeting, October 2016 financial reports, repeal of policy INJD Technology, and approved GDBA-E-4 Transportation Personnel 2016-17 Annual Wage Schedule.
