Meeting of January 12, 2017

Employment. The Board approved Billie Jo Culp as a Guest Teacher (Certified). The Board also approved David Teem as a Guest (Classified) Bus Driver.

Items from the Audience. Keshawn Duran was presented with his High School Diploma.

Mr. Webb shared an email that recognized Ms. Harvey and Mr. Wiedeman for their continued dedication to the students.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Webb reported the Mr. Harvey Sullivan passed away. His services will be at the High School on Monday at 2:00 p.m. The district will have early release at 1:00 p.m.

He also reported the City has agreed to pay to have the backflow preventer replaced. The district will need to insert screens to prevent this from happening in other areas.

We have two grants that we are interested in. The Turnaround Leadership Plan (TLP) which focuses on leadership within the school. Teachers become turnaround leaders in the classrooms and are eligible for certification from CDE. The other grant is Connect for Success Grant. This grant is about getting the entire staff involved by allowing teachers to visit other schools, provide money for teachers to work together for planning and hire an instructional coach.

Other Action Items. The Board approved the minutes of the Dec 15, 2016 meeting after amending, the fiscal year 2016 annual fiscal audit, special meeting on January 25, 2017 at 7 a.m. to approve the revised 2016-2017 budget, transportation waiver, and donation to the Education Foundation in memory of Harvey Sullivan.

Reports. Mr. Reschke reported BOCES has not had a meeting and the City/District meeting has been postponed. Mr. Wilkinson reported the Education Foundation has set up a Facebook page. They helped fund an activity at Bill Metz for UNICEF bands for an elective class. Students who received the Ritchey Scholarship last year could reapply for their sophomore year. There is a possibility they will be able to apply their junior and senior years as well. A couple of students from the High School attended the meeting representing their clubs and student body.
