Meeting of March 9, 2017

Employment. The Board accepted the retirement resignation from Cynthia Baird as High School Language Arts Teacher, Dan Garcia as High School Art Teacher and Judi Golden with Food Service all effective at the end of the 2016-17 school year. The Board also accepted resignations from Laurel Heimstra as 7th Grade Language Arts Teacher, Shauna Ianson as DELTA/OLA Counselor, both effective at the end of the 2016-17 school year; and Jake Prendergast as 8th Grade Social Studies Teacher Effective February 27, 2017. Rebekah Sparks was approved to transfer to the Math Instructional Coach position for the 2017-2018 school year.

Items from the Audience. Erika Medina, Junior Class President, and Emma DeHerrera, Junior Class Vice President, presented details for the 2017-2018 senior class trip. Kevin Morris with Clean Energy presented their proposal for the school district to purchase a part of the solar project down by La Jara. Questions were answered as they came up. Jenny Noonan designed shirts for Marsh and presented one to each of the Board members.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Webb discussed using part of the middle school property to build a solar collection farm. We are checking with CDE to see if we can use BEST money to pay for the roof at Marsh to be fixed, to fix the way the DELTA Center roof drains, and the heating at the Middle School. The roof at Marsh is leaking over the old part of the building and must be fixed this summer. The DELTA CENTER roof is not draining properly. The heating at the middle school is not working properly in the 7th and 8th grade rooms. Mr. Webb demonstrated the SCAP Website and explained the work that has been done.

Other Action Items. The Board approved the minutes from the February 16th meeting, January 2017 Financial Reports, Purchase service agreement with Ethan Huff, revision to policy GCBA-R Instructional Staff Contracts/Compensation/Salary Schedules, and the Clean Energy Purchase Service Agreement as proposed. The Board also approved to update the signature cards to current signers on the two accounts at Rio Grande Savings and Loan and sending a resolution letter to Sun Flower Bank to close the general fund sweep account to transfer to CSAFE. The Board accepted the land donation from Michael Trujillo. The Board approved moving into executive session for the discussion of personnel.

Reports. Mr. Reschke reported BOCES has not had a meeting. The next meeting will be on March 15th. Mr. Wilkinson reported the Education Foundation received additional funds for the Ritchey Scholarship and gave an update on the funds donated in memory of Harvey Sullivan. Mr. Tichy presented on the 8th Grade end of the year trip to the University of New Mexico.
