

Graduation Requirements

Specific Coursework required for graduation from Monte Vista High School:

Language Arts: Four units of credit are required with a minimum grade of “D” for each course.

Students must complete the equivalent of a Senior Essay and Senior Research Project.

Math: Three or four units (depending on diploma type) are required with a minimum grade of “D” for each course.

Science Three or four units (depending on diploma type) with a minimum grade of “D” for each course. There are prerequisites set by the Science Department that may preclude entrance into a specific class or classes.

Social Studies Three units of credit with a minimum grade of “D” for each course.

Keyboarding One unit of credit is required. Students may choose from course work appropriate to their abilities.

Physical Education One unit of credit is required with a minimum grade of “D” for each course.

Practical Arts Credit is required from the following departments: Business, Family and Consumer Studies, or Industrial Arts. An equivalent credit may be waived for an appropriate course of study with prior approval from the administration.

Fine Arts Credit is required from either Music or Art. Specific courses offered by the Language Arts Department also meet the requirement. An equivalent of one fourth credit per performance may be waived with prior approval by the administration.
