

## **Interscholastic Athletics**

Interscholastic athletic competition is limited to football, volleyball, basketball, wrestling, track, baseball, golf, and cross country.

Training directions rendered by school personnel will be limited to generally prescribed health practices.

The financing of trips will be limited to the bare necessities and will be kept as nearly as possible in line with expenditures made for other activities.

Safety practices will meet those directed by the Colorado High School Activities Association.

All arrangements for games, requisitioning of equipment, instruction of students, and other elements of the program will have constant supervision by the athletic director under the direction of the principal as is given to any other curricular area.

Each student intending to participate in athletics will have the permission of the parent and the principal.

Coaches are to be relieved of all responsibility for settlement of complaints or differences between schools or for differences resulting from officiation. The principal is the only agent of the school involved in such relations. The training of the players, their conduct on the field, and the instruction in the playing of the game is the responsibility of the coach.

### Uniforms

The school will furnish the uniform required. Such uniforms will be maintained in a condition to afford complete protection for the student. Whenever such condition does not exist, a written report will be filed with the administration and referred to the Board of Education.

All student participants will furnish all personal clothing such as supporter, mouth protector, underclothing, and shoes.
