Meeting of January 21, 2021

Employment. The Board accepted the resignation of Cynthia Oringdulph – MS Behavior Interventionist (effective 1/15/2021) and Alisha Myers – Marsh Special Education Teacher (effective end of the 2020-21 school year). The Board approved Manuel Castanuela – Part-time custodian, Jerry Clare – Bus Driver, Mike Medina – HS Assistant Girls Basketball Coach, Juan Calixto-Tomas – Migrant Tutor and Lizbeth Plascencia Benavides – Migrant Tutor. The Board approved certified substitutes, Isaiah Duran and Aleceya Mortensen and classified substitute, Christopher Villagomez.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Wiedeman reported the increase in ESSER funds will help maintain the smaller classroom sizes at the Elementary level for the coming school year and replace teachers on the secondary level that were not replaced this year. Loss of learning programs are proceeding (i.e. Friday School and Summer School). Adams State students will be participating in the Migrant tutoring program. The District and Department of Health worked together to come up with a plan for the basketball season amid the COVID concerns and recommendations. The measures include limiting spectators, fogging between games in the gyms and locker rooms, mask wearing, etc. The District will be hosting the Middle School Basketball tournament on February 5th and 6th using all three gyms.
