Meeting of September 13, 2018

Employment. The Board approved the resignation of Daniel Gallegos as Bus Driver. The Board approved the following certified employee Shelby Mortensen as Part-School Nurse. The Board approved the following classified employees: Esteban Aguilera as MS Boys Basketball Coach, Shelby Heredia as Marsh Paraprofessional, Arnold Martinez as Bus Driver, Cynthia Oringdulph as Middle School Behavioral Interventionist, Lynora Soto as High School Secretary and Ingrid Watson as BME Secretary. Items from the Audience. Mr. Woodke updated the Board on the activities of the Skills USA chapter. Daniel Miller thanked the Board for their support of his trip to Louisville, Kentucky to participate in the National competition for electrical construction. Mr. Wright introduced the new Delta/OLA math teacher, Glenn Pace and Mr. Tichy introduced the new 7th grade math teacher, Annie Pace.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Webb reported the District has been recommended for EARRS 2.0 grant funding. The District is looking for BEST grant funding to address some building issues at the Middle School. The National Forum to Advance Rural Education will be held in Denver the 2nd week of October. Amendment 73 – the superintendents' recommendation for funding schools would stabilize and increase funding for the District.

Discussion: The LED light project is moving forward and the projected savings on electricity will be significant. The CASB Regional Meeting will be on Monday, September 24th in Alamosa.

Other Action Items. The Board approved the minutes from the August 16, 2018 meeting, July Financial Reports, adopted Amendment 73 Resolution, the Resolution for LED Light Project, Non-Eligible Student Transportation Requests, and approved policies revisions for JLCD – Administering Medications to Students, JLCD-R – Administering Medications to Students, JLCD-E-1 – Stock Epinephrine Auto-injectors, Standing Order and Procedure, JLCD-E-2 – Asthma/Allergy Self Carry Contract and JLCD-E-3 – Agreement for Students Independently Managing Their Diabetes.

The teachers are digging into the curriculum and finding it offers many options for teaching math concepts to the students.
