Meeting of October 15, 2015

Resignation. The Board accepted the resignation of Wayne Sheldrake as a MS Paraprofessional.

Employment. The Board approved Kayla Hensley (pending receipt of license) and Katie Turner as certified guest teachers; Jennifer Brady, Gary Johnson, and Mary Price as guest teachers with one-year substitute authorizations (all pending receipt of authorizations); Benjamin Beckner (bus driver), Gretchen Dawn Ford (bus driver), Gary Johnson (bus driver) and Mary Price (paraprofessional/secretary) as classified guest employees; and HS student Angel Hayes as a temporary classified employee (food service).

Requisitions. The Board approved purchase orders to Samy A Construction in the amount of \$9,180.00 for change orders on the HS Athletic Facility, and to CDW Government Inc. in the amount of \$14,335.50 for Chromebooks, management licenses, and mice.

Black Out Days Appeal Process. The Board approved a process that allows employees to appeal Black Out Leave Days. Commencing with the 2015-16 school year employees are prohibited from taking leave days on the day before or the day after any scheduled holiday or break, and on the first and last student days. If leave is taken on any of these days, the employee's pay will be docked in the amount equal to one day's salary. The Personal Leave Appeals Team may grant an exception to the salary dock through the appeal process.

Other Reports. The Board heard reports from the Education Foundation and on conversations between City and District representatives.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Webb reported on decreased state funding for education, increased student enrollment, E-rate changes, a re-insurance fee, possible changes to the Voluntary Separation Plan, potential funds for an alternative middle school, issues with Curriculum Loft, the EARSS Grant, and the Student Centered Accountability Project (SCAP).

Other Action Items. The Board approved transportation waivers, a CHSAA resolution, a policy adoption, policy revisions, August Financial Reports, and Minutes from the September 10, 2015 meeting.

Discussion Items. The Board reviewed a number of policies.

Next Meeting. The next regular Board of Education meeting was scheduled for Thursday, November 12, 2015, with regular session at 6:00 p.m.

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
