

Organization of Instruction

The Board of Education shall provide a system of education extending from kindergarten through grade 12. It also is responsible for a preschool program based on the number of slots allocated by the state department of education, special education for disabled children, adult education, and education for limited-English proficient students.

The schools of the district shall be organized to present a unified program of instruction and shall be operated as a single system under the direction of the superintendent of schools.

The grouping and housing of instructional levels in school facilities shall be as follows:

Monte Vista Middle School	Grades 6 through 8
Monte Vista High School	Grades 9 through 12
