## **Graduation Exercises**

Students graduating with a 3.0 grade point average or above will graduate with honors. Students graduating with a 3.5 grade point average or above will graduate with high honors. This grade point average will be figured at the end of the final marking period of the senior year. Grade point averages will be carried out two decimal places. The grade point average for students staffed into the special education program will include only grades earned from non-special education courses into which the students have been "main streamed".

Seniors honored will be called forward and draped with an honor cord, silver for honors, and green and gold for high honors.

Students graduating who have been elected to a school sponsored club/activity office at district, regional, state, or national level by peers from school districts in addition to their own will graduate with "leadership recognition." In order to receive this award, students must have held at least one leadership position above school level during the previous eight semesters.

Seniors so honored will be provided a red and blue leadership cord prior to the ceremony and their names will be annotated as such in the program.
