

Byron Syring DELTA Center Admission Policies

1. Adult students (over 18) may be admitted at any point in the school year.
2. High school students may be admitted only during the following periods:
 1. Open enrollment through October 1.
 2. Students will be enrolled during the first two weeks of the second semester and the first week of an academic quarter.
3. Students that have dropped out of school and students transferring from Monte Vista High School will be given first priority.
4. Students transferring from Monte Vista High School must meet the following guidelines.
 1. Student must be recommended by the high school counselor and accepted by the DELTA Center Director after a meeting with the student's parents.
 2. Must be 16 years of age. (Special allowances may be made for Teen Moms.)
 3. Credit total must make it impossible to graduate with their class
 4. A minimum of three credits and a Community/Civic Involvement Project must be completed at the DELTA Center to earn a DELTA Center diploma.
5. Monte Vista High School students may, at the high school counselor's request, take specific courses at the DELTA Center to make up lost credits. Courses taken will be considered extension courses and a tuition fee will be charged.
