

Medicaid Reimbursement

In all cases in which a student is enrolled in the Colorado Medicaid program, the Monte Vista School District shall seek reimbursement for health-related services rendered by qualified district staff. District staff shall make a reasonable effort to coordinate care with the student's health care provider to avoid duplication of services.

As a Medicaid provider, the district shall access Medicaid eligibility information for students from Health Care Policy and Financing ("HCPF"). HCPF is the designated Medicaid agency for the state of Colorado.

Information shall annually be distributed to parents which contains the following statement: "As a Medicaid provider, the Monte Vista School District will access Medicaid eligibility information for students from Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF), the designated Medicaid agency in the state. Directory information of name, date of birth, and gender will be released to HCPF to verify Medicaid eligibility. With consent, the description of health and health-related services delivered to Medicaid eligible students will be released to Medicaid and/or the district-billing agent for proper administration of the program. A dated record of all transactions will be kept on file at the San Luis Valley Board of Cooperative Services School Medicaid office. Parents may revoke their consent at any time by calling 589-5851."

All ongoing health and related services shall be rendered by qualified district staff pursuant to an individual health services plan signed by a professional qualified to provide the types of services described in the plan. The plan may be an Individual Education Plan (IEP), Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP), Section 504 Accommodation Plan or any individual health services plan.
