

Guidance and Counseling

Guidance and counseling shall be regarded as an intimate feature of the instructional program and supervisory service. It shall be devoted to the broad field of personality development as well as to the specific matters of selecting courses, progress in school, morals, manners, physical development, choice of career and getting and holding a job, and the development of interpersonal relations skills. The program shall emphasize training and experience in the making of decisions and in acting upon them.
