Student Donations and Gifts

Solicitations

The solicitation of donations and contributions from students shall be restricted to drives approved by the Board.

Any outside organization desiring to distribute flyers or other materials to students in connection with fund drives may do so only with the approval of the principal.

Gifts

Students shall be discouraged from the routine presentation of gifts to district employees. When a student feels a spontaneous desire to present a gift to a staff member, the gift shall not be elaborate or unduly expensive. The Board shall consider as always welcome, and in most cases more appropriate than gifts, the writing of letters to staff members expressing gratitude or appreciation.

Because of the embarrassment that might result among children, students shall be discouraged from giving gifts to classroom teachers and other school personnel. For the same reason, there will be no formal exchange of gifts between students in the classroom.
